**3:** What is the total number of adults and children living with HIV?

**33 million** (for comparison the UK population is approx 60 million)

**4:** Approximately how many new HIV infections occur each day?

**6,800**

**5:** HIV and AIDS is a particular problem in developing countries. What percentage of people with HIV and AIDS live in sub Saharan Africa?

**68**

**6:** How many children are orphaned by AIDS-related illness every hour?

**240** (1 child every 15 seconds)

**7:** What was the total number of children (0-18 years) who had lost one or both parents to AIDS-related illness at the end of 2006?

**15 million**

**8:** How many child-headed households are there in Rwanda alone?

**As many as 10 thousand**

**9:** What percentage of households in Swaziland is run by orphans?

**10 percent**

**10:** How many children under 15 die each year from an AIDS-related-illness?

**1,400**
